## Camping en français in Rocky Mountain House, Alberta- August 18 till August 20, 2023

#### **DISCLAIMER CLAUSE**

The Board of Directors of Canadian Parents for French Alberta and Northwest Territories Branch ("CPF ALBERTA & NWT") AND their agents, officials, officers, directors, employees, volunteers, contractors, servants or representatives (hereinafter refer to as "The Releasees) are not responsible for any death, injury, loss or damage of any kind suffered by any person while participating in this event and all related activities of this event, including injury, loss or damage which might be caused by the negligence of THE RELEASEES. This event includes activities around Rocky Mountain House Historic Site and other activities organized by the CPF Alberta & NWT.

While participating in events held or sponsored CPF Alberta & NWT, consistent with AHS guidelines, participants will be practicing hand hygiene, "Social distancing" when possible, and recommend wearing face coverings in public indoor locations and group transportation to reduce the risks of exposure to COVID-19. Because COVIID - 19 is extremely contagious and is spread mainly from person-to-person contact, CPF Alberta & NWT has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
