MONITOR PROGRAM

CPF Alberta loves to get our youth involved and for our upcoming Falling into French Weekend, we are please to introduce our Monitor Program! All youth participating in the monitor program will receive the following:

- A letter of reference for their portfolios
- Free participation in a specially planned evening activity for youth between 12 & 18
- An honorarium

Youth between the ages of 12-18 will have the following opportunities:

Babysitter - Ages 12+

*Preference will be given to those with a babysitters course & Basic First Aid

- Babysitting children under the age of 5 (at the hotel) while parents attend AGM, parent session and parent activity;
- Facilitating activities for these children;
- Facilitating the children's basic physical needs (e.g. washroom, snack and beverage); and
- Communicating with the parents in regards to issues and concerns.



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Youth between the ages of 12-18 will have the following opportunities:

Monitor-in-Training (MIT) - Ages 12-15

- These individuals will act as a role model for the younger youth by participating in the events and helping monitors where needed.
- The (MITs) will have varying responsibilities determined by the ages of the youth that they will be working with.

Monitor - Ages 16+

- Supervising a group of children while they participate in the planned activities;
- Managing any and all situations which may arise with the participants;
- Supervising the MITs assigned to help with that group;
- Mentoring the MITs so that they can develop new skills;
- Report any issues, concerns or challenges back to CPF Staff.

*All youth activities will be supervised by an adult 18+.
